Introduction to the history of France	<p>KNOWLEDGE:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - chronology of France prehistory and history until today - point of reference regarding political, social and economic, and artistic trends and movements <p>DESIGNATED SKILLS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - the ability to position oneself in time concerning the history of France (in a European context) - the ability to connect important events, French heritage and places of remembrance - the ability to position oneself better in French (and European) space - language proficiency: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - improve oral comprehension - learn a specific vocabulary (historical) - improve written expression - knowing how to do researches (books /internet)
Block 2	Number of hours: 25H 5 ECTS
Introduction to French literature	<p>AIMS, PURPOSES:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - the discovery of the historical and social context of France through French literature from the Middle Ages until the 17th c. <p>KNOWLEDGE:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - chronology of literary movements - authors and works of French literature <p>DESIGNATED SKILLS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - methodology: analyses / text commentary / reading report / presentation / ability to do gather information in books and on the internet - language: improve oral and written skills, learn specific vocabulary - AND ABOVE ALL encouraging the pleasure of reading

Block 3	Number of hours: 40H (language transversal programme into 3 levels) 5 ECTS
French language and civilisation	<p>The language and civilization course is offered on several levels. Depending on the starting level, that will be evaluated, a group will be proposed. The objectives of the proposed levels are B1, B2 or C1, C2 (European Framework of Reference for Languages). The contents offered in the language course cover the essential points of the language (grammar, phonology, lexicon) and the 6 language activities (written and oral expression, written and oral comprehension, interaction, mediation). The course often feeds on the immediate language needs of international students in Le Havre.</p> <p>The course of civilization will focus on everything that constitutes contemporary French culture and civilization. Some historical reminders will be brought but it is especially the France of today which will be studied.</p> <p>The proposed levels being multiple, the course will necessarily be adapted.</p>
Block 4	Number of hours: 20H 3 ECTS
Personal Project of documentary research	<p>This project allows the student to get acquainted with his field of specialty (in his home country) but in French. The work is built around methodological and linguistic proposals on various topics such as the written or oral presentation, the bibliography, the presentation materials... The work of the student is spread over time so that his project feeds progressively of all these tools.</p>
