

REGIONAL ECONOMICS PROGRAM



CAMPUSES

- Puebla:** Located in one of the best districts of the city, opened its doors in 2003. On 25 hectares, you will find excellent facilities with classrooms equipped with state-of-the-art technology as well as cafeterias, gymnasium, fields and courts to practice your favorite sport. 

- **Querétaro:** Campus Querétaro is the fourth largest campus in the country with more than 7000 students, of which 55% are from other states and more than 400 international students from around the world. Queretaro is located in the heart of Mexico, just a two-hour drive from Mexico City. Its great location, modern infrastructure, diversity of people, food and touristic places make the state one of the best destinations to visit. Queretaro is one of the safest, innovative and state-of-the-art sectors in industrial production, education and technology
- **Monterrey:** The main campus of Tec de Monterrey is located in a modern industrial and business center only 230 Km far from the USA border. The city, also known as "La Ciudad de las Montañas" (City of the Mountains), hosts a set of transnational conglomerates with 10 out of 20 of the most important Mexican firms. The campus has been designed to create the perfect environment, motivating the engagement of intensive academic activity with research as well as recreation, allowing the full innovative and entrepreneurial potential of students and faculty to flourish.

Students will learn and advance their skills by taking 2 courses:

EC3014 – Regional Economics

(taught in English)

Advanced economics course focusing on the study of economics in its territorial setting by combining relevant theoretical and empirical elements. It addresses topics related to sustainable development such as pollution, resource depletion. Productivity and consumption patterns, employment, unemployment and equity. This course will require prior knowledge of economic growth and development. As a learning outcome, students will understand the behavior of the economy at regional level, in particular, the territorial concentration and dispersal processes as well as the marked disparity in economic development at the subnational level and the logic that determines the localization of productive activities.

EC3016 – Mexican Economics Seminar

(taught in English)

Advanced course in which students integrate the theory and study methods of economic science in the specific analysis of the Mexican economy. This course requires prior knowledge of economic theory and economic science study methods. As a learning outcome, students will conduct a scientific research project using economic theory and a topic related to the Mexican economy.
