METHODOLOGY

- Use of authentic visual, audio and written documents.
- Realization of student activities (writing an email, preparing a presentation, etc.) to develop interacting knowledge, skills and attitudes.
- Oral and written work, individually or in small groups depending on the activities.

CONTENTS

- Educational activities for successful studies at the UPJV : writing, presentations, etc.
- Thematic workshops (heritage, traditions and symbols, gastronomy, family, the government the French population, French identities and values, etc.).

COURSE MATERIALS

- Daily writings: instructions and forms, press articles, brochures, emails, etc.
- Writings prepared: academic texts (conference proceedings, lectures), literary texts (excerpts from novels, fables, poetry, short stories, tales, etc.) ; types of texts (argumentative, informative/explanatory, descriptive/narrative, injunctive)
- Iconographic documents: advertising posters, photos, drawings, paintings, comic strips, caricatures, etc.
- Audiovisual documents: videos, TCF-type recordings, radio clips, film clips, film clips, news clips, documentaries, videos hosted on the Internet, video clips, conference clips, etc.

ASSESSMENT

- Diagnostic assessment: placement tests provided by the Centre FLE.
- Evaluation: continuous assessment (both in oral and written comprehension and production)
