Official Transcript	<p>Upload a transcript from your current/most recent institution.</p> <p>Your transcript must show grades and subjects for all semesters, including the latest one since your enrollment.</p> <p>Your transcript must be officially signed or stamped by your university/school. E-transcripts are acceptable.</p> <p>Graduate students must upload transcripts from both their undergraduate and graduate institution.</p>	<p>In the “Documents” section of ISEP application, under “Upload Your Transcript”.</p>

<p>Photo for Student ID card/Certificate of Eligibility</p>	<p>The photo must meet the following File Size and Photograph Requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Minimum: 800×600 Pixels ▪ Minimum: 100 KB ▪ Max: 10 MB <p>The photo CANNOT be the same photo you used in your passport.</p> <p>Example of the photo can be found here</p>	<p>In the “Documents” section of the ISEP application, under “Upload Additional Documents”.</p>
<p>Official Bank Statement</p>	<p>Bank Statement Instructions</p> <p>Minimum: 650,000 JPY</p> <p>Upload a bank statement of those who will cover your expenses during staying in Japan.</p> <p>E.x. if your parent/guardian will help cover your general expenses, please submit the statement of your parent/guardian's bank account. You can submit more than one bank statement if necessary. You can redact any sensitive information (i.e. address, SSN), but you must keep the account name, number, date of issue, and latest balance amount.</p> <p>If you plan to cover the amount with scholarships or loans, please submit a letter from your financial aid office confirming your prospective award. You can submit a combination of both proof of your scholarships/aid + a bank statement.</p> <p>For the conversion from JPY, if you cannot add it directly onto your bank statement, you can type it on a Word Document and attach it as the first page of your file.</p>	<p>In the “Documents” section of the ISEP application, under “Upload Additional Documents”.</p>
<p>Casual Photo</p>	<p>Upload any casual photo of you. It just needs to have you as the main subject.</p> <p>The photo file size must be a maximum 20 MB.</p>	<p>In the “Documents” section of the ISEP application, under “Upload Additional Documents”.</p>

Copy of Passport	<p>Upload a scanned copy of the biographical page of your passport as a .jpg, .png, or .pdf file.</p> <p>If you do not have a passport, you should apply for one immediately. In the meantime, upload a copy of your passport application in the Nanzan application.</p>	<p>In the “Biography” section of the ISEP application, under “Upload Copy of Passport”. If you do not have your passport yet, click “No” for the question that asks, “Do you have a passport”?</p>
Letter of Recommendation	<p>Download the Nanzan recommendation form in the following link: Letter of Recommendation Read carefully the following instructions below: LoR Instructions</p> <p>It can be the same person as your ISEP academic reference. They can also input the same content they wrote for your ISEP application.</p>	<p>Ask the instructor to submit the form via email to cjs-forms@ic.nanzan-u.ac.jp by no later than March 1st (Fall Applicants) or September 1st (Spring Applicants) so that it’s in early.</p>
