# Introduction

Universidad Privada Boliviana (UPB) is a leading QS IV Star University in Bolivia.

The university is ranked as *#one* in Bolivia in International rankings.

The University has three modern campuses in Cochabamba, La Paz, and Santa Cruz, with this program exclusive to the Cochabamba campus. The city, home to around one million residents, features a pleasant climate, safety, and a low cost of living.

## Program

**This is a unique 20-week program offered entirely in English and taught by Bolivian professors with international background. International students will share the same classroom as local students for effective cultural exchange.**

All students will have to complete four or five courses to receive the certificate. All students will be offered internship. You may request a certificate and credits for internship as well. during the semester you may travel around Bolivia to enjoy its beauty.

## Benefits

## Features

- Take four or five undergraduate courses (3 credit each)
- A five-week of in-company internship (3 credits)
- Travel to beautiful touristic places
- Opportunity to learn and improve your Spanish
- A non-credit certificate in Spanish language
- Admissions preference to ISEP affiliated and partner university students

## Elegibility

Students nominated by ISEP and Partner universities are given priority admissions. Since the program and courses are of generic nature, students from any faculty are encouraged to apply. It will be useful thought , if you have completed at least three semesters of university level undergraduate studies.

Freemovers are welcome to apply by paying normal university tuition and fees.





## Duration and semesters

This is one semester program, usually of 20 weeks Beginning early February to end of June, or beginning early August to mid-December.

### Applications deadline

(February-June semester)

The deadline is October 31

(August-December semester)

The deadline is April 30

### Tuition and Fees

- There will be NO tuition for the ISEP affiliated university students and for the partner university students.
- Freemover students pay normal university tuition and fees.
- Students may require to pay some symbolic fees for ID card or membership for sport clubs or similar activities.

## Accommodation

The university does not have a campus accommodation for students. We would recommend you to come and stay in a hotel for a couple of days. Your student buddies will help you find private accommodation. At this point of time, it is very easy to find a student private accommodation.

## Buddy System & Collection from the airport

Each participant will be assigned one or two student buddies to collect you from the local airport, as well as help you in your early days.

## Credits & academic system

Each course and internship will be worth three credits. Each course corresponds to 48 hours of class-room interaction plus 48 hours homework. Grading marks are from 0-100. For passing a course you need 60 marks. The semester is divided into four quarters of 5-week each.

## Costs & Budget

- The cost of living in Cochabamba is relatively low. A well-furnished private studios can cost anywhere between \$150-250 per month.
- A meal at a reasonably priced restaurant can cost from \$3 to \$5. The travel within a town can cost \$15-\$20 per month.
- Depending on how you live, the budget for a month can be between \$250 to \$600
