



Student Life


In charge of the Dean of Admissions and Student Affairs, it is part of the set of departments that offer a complete service and well-being to students:

UPB's Modular Program

Thanks to UPB's modular program, you will be able to develop professional competencies. This educational method allows you to stay focused on two subjects every 5 weeks so that you can dedicate all your efforts to fulfill the high demands of the university.

In undergraduate, the year is divided into two semesters. Running from February to June (semester 1) and from August to December (semester 2), these are composed of 4 modules each.

Other short programs are scheduled during the summer or winter terms.
