

If student stay longer than 3 months a multiple-entry national visa D is issued for the period not exceeding one year (12 months).

We strongly recommend obtaining a national visas D for all Non-EU students **before arrival to Lithuania!**

<b>Number of mediation letter</b>	<a href="#">Request form</a>	The Letter of Mediation is submitted electronically through the Lithuanian Migration Information System (MIGRIS). The electronic information system provides the mediation letter with the number, which the student indicates upon arriving at the Embassy.  <b>Valid for 30 days</b> after the letter is submitted to MIGRIS.
<b>Consular fee</b> (at the Embassy/visa centre)	60-120 EUR	In certain cases, no fee is applied. Some of embassies accept consular fee only in cash.
<b>State fee</b> (at the Migration Department)	Free of charge	In Lithuania

The national D visa allows students to stay in other Schengen Member States up to 90 days within the period of 180 days.

If you have a **valid temporary residence permit or a national visa issued by another Member State of the European Union for study purposes** and you are covered by a programme funded by the European Union or its Member States that promotes the mobility of third-country nationals within the European Union or an agreement between two or more higher educational institutions, you may come to continue out of your studies and stay in the Republic of Lithuania without a visa for a maximum of 360 days. ***No additional registration in Lithuania.***
